Optimum time for pruning is soon after harvest for deciduous fruit trees. Winter pruning should be done when the weather is dry. Fertilise in early spring, summer and autumn, citrus 4 times a year. Trees not fruiting generally lack potassium. If you prune lemons one quarter of the tree at a time, by the time you get back to where you started you should have fruit most of the year.
